

- Leader: Bow-tie wearing Janusz Korwin-Mikke, 71
- In brief: Wants to turn the EU Parliament into a brothel
- Vote share: 7%

- In brief: Neo Nazi, wants detention camps for 'deviant' Roma. Anti-Semitic.
- Vote share: 15%





- De-Modernization: lesser role of political and economic rationality
- New Archaic: extreme conservatisms shaping Big Anti-Europe

# IDEOLOGICAL PROCESSES

- Darkness from East: failure of liberal democracy in post-Soviet Europe
- EU contradiction: super-national bureaucracy VS national politics
- Nativist Euroscepticism: discursive victory of particularism
- Big Ant-Europe: equivalence of particularist forces in the East and West
